

Are we Eligible? Quick Screen

Has your organization:

- ✓ Been formally established as a legal entity to provide charitable services in Ontario;
- ✓ Been in existence for at least one year;
- ✓ Provided charitable community services consistent with the primary purposes of the organization for at least <u>one</u> year.

Do your organization's objects, purposes and activities fall within at least one of the four classifications:

- ✓ 1. The relief of poverty
- ✓ 2. The advancement of education
- ✓ 3. The advancement of religion
- ✓ 4. Other charitable purposes beneficial to the community, not falling under 1, 2 or 3

Does your organization:

- ✓ Have a place of business in Ontario;
- ✓ Have an established organizational structure;
- ✓ Operate separately (organizationally, legally and financially) from any other organization;
- ✓ Benefit the public at large, not a private group;
- ✓ Undertake projects with a charitable purpose as one of its main aims and normal activities;
- ✓ Propose to use proceeds for charitable purposes that benefit Ontario and its residents; and
- ✓ Assume full responsibility for the conduct and management of its lottery events.

If you answered 'yes' to all of these questions, your organization may be eligible for lottery licensing.
