NOTICE OF PASSING BY-LAW 6948/94/21 TO CHANGE WARD BOUNDARIES IN THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE

Take notice that on Monday, November 8, 2021, the Council of the City of Port Colborne passed by-law 6948/94/21 pursuant to Section 222 of the Municipal Act, 2001, with respect to the re-division of ward boundaries. The purpose of this by-law is to change the boundaries of ward one and ward three.

Under subsection 222(4) of the Municipal Act, 2001, any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) if they have any objection to the by-law passed by the municipality.

Appeals must be filed with the City Clerk, 66 Charlotte Street, Port Colborne, ON, L3K 3C8. The Appellant or Applicant must set out the objections to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objections along with a cheque or money order in the amount of \$1,100.00 made payable to the Minister of Finance. The appeal form (Appellant Form A1) is available online through OLT's website. Appeals must be filed within 45 days of the by-law being passed. The last day for filing an appeal is December 23, 2021.

The personal information accompanying your submission is collected under the authority of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, and can form part of the public record which may be released to the public.
