

Public Meeting – Building Permit Fee By-law – August 9

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Port Colborne will hold a public meeting to consider a proposed new Building Permit Fee By-law under Section 7 of the Building Code Act.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT The City of Port Colborne is proposing to adopt a new Building Permit Fee By-law following a review of the building permit fees under Section 7(b) of the Building Code Act.

The effect will be to increase the existing fee structure and introduce new fees for building permit applications. A public meeting was previously held on June 14, 2022. Further changes are proposed to the building permit fees and as such, in accordance with the Building Code Act another public meeting is being held.
